On March 12, 2023, Project Coordinator Aruna had a meeting with the Gram Pradhan of Gadanpur Gram Panchayat in Block Ahirori. During the meeting, photocopies of Aadhar-linked bank passbooks were provided for 20 women's. This initiative aims to extend the benefits of the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana to economically disadvantaged families in addition to addressing toilet needs. Furthermore, it opens the door for these families to avail themselves of the MNREGA scheme. Pradhan Ji expressed a commitment to collaborative efforts in advancing the development of the village. The ongoing progress in toilet-related work is anticipated to yield benefits for the deserving families in the near future.
